

## Botallack village to the Count House walk

Enjoy this 1-mile walk from the bus stop in Botallack village to the Count House. From here, you can enjoy a walk on the Tin Coast spotting wildlife and learning about the important mining history in this part of Cornwall. You can also enjoy a warm pasty or hot drink from Botallack Count House café.

Start point: Queen's Arms bus stop, Queen's Arms, Botallack, Penzance TR19 7QG

- From the Queen's Arms bus stop, head north along the road passing The Black Well B&B on your left.
- 2. When you reach a junction, turn left.
- 3. Keep right to stay on the track and look out for views of the old mining engine houses and chimney stacks ahead.
- 4. You will arrive at Botallack, and the Count House will be on your right.

End point: Botallack Count House, Botallack Mine, St Just, Penzance TR19 7QQ
