


CORNWALL

St Just to Cape Cornwall walk

Embark on this short, 1-mile walk from the bus stop in St Just to Cape Cornwall on the coast, from where you can explore the history and wildlife of the Tin Coast.

U Watch for traffic

Please be aware that this route is the main road leading to Cape Cornwall, please watch out for traffic.

Activity: Walking

Moderate: Part of Cape Cornwall Road goes down hill and is quite steep in some sections. It is a tarmacked road, that can be uneven in places.

Dog friendly: Dogs on leads welcome. Please be aware that as this is the main road leading to Cape Cornwall there is traffic on this route. Cape Cornwall was a mining area and there are old mineshafts, uneven terrain and steep drops. There is a seasonal dog ban on the beach and slipway from Easter Sunday to 30 September.

Full trail: Miles: 1 (km: 1.6)

Duration: 20 mins

Total steps: 3

Start point: Bus stop Cape Cornwall School, St Just, Penzance TR19 7LF.

- 1. From the bus stop outside Cape Cornwall School head down Cape Cornwall Road with the sea ahead of you.
- 2. At Boswedden House keep left to stay on Cape Cornwall Road, passing Cape Cornwall golf club until you see the cape in view ahead.
- 3. When you arrive at Cape Cornwall, you'll see the National Trust car park and facilities on your left and the cape ahead of you.

End point: National Trust Cape Cornwall, St Just, Penzance TR19 7NN
