


CORNWALL

Terrain

Park Head is an easy, level walk through grassland and fields to the clifftops with an occassional gate. It can get muddy in winter.

Total steps: 4

Start point: Park Head National Trust car park, grid ref: SW853707

- 1. From the car park go through adjacent kissing gate and follow the field edge path.
- 2. At the second gate, turn left and follow the route out to the cliffs and the coast path.
- 3. Turn right and follow the coast path to a stone hedge, where there's a seat to rest and take in the views.
- 4. Return the same way you came.

End point: Park Head National Trust car park, grid ref: SW853707
