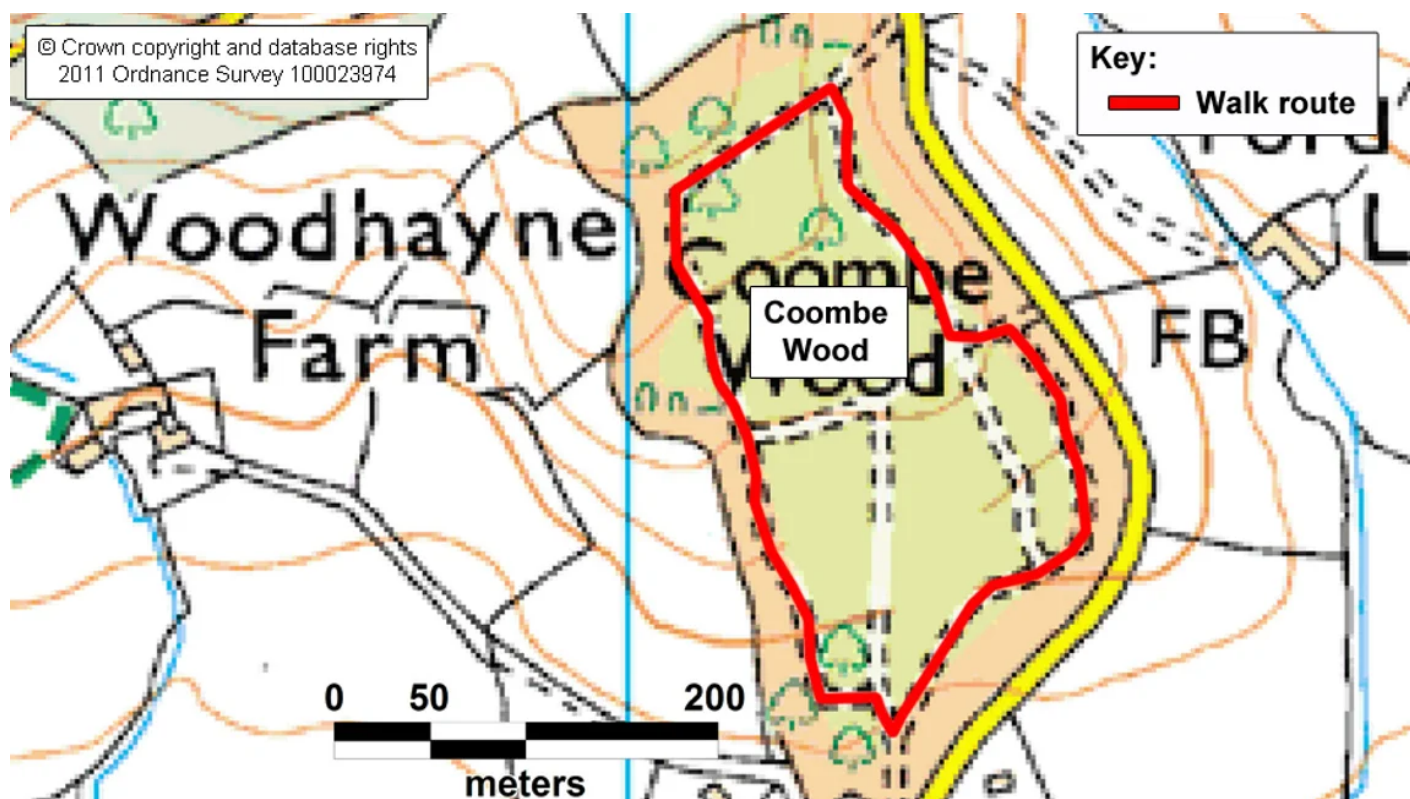

Combe Woods and wild flowers walk

You can enjoy this circular walk around Combe Wood at any time of the year but the route is at its very best during bluebell season in early May.



Information

Address: Combe Wood, near Honiton, Devon, EX14 4TG

OS map: Landranger 179

Activity: Walking

Easy: The terrain is generally flat with some slight slopes and paths. For further details, please see Terrain section.

Dog friendly: Well-behaved dogs are welcome but please keep them on a lead as there's wildlife nearby.

Full trail: Miles: 1 (km: 1.6)

Duration: 30 mins - 40 mins

Terrain

The terrain here is generally flat with some slight slopes and paths. It can get muddy in wet weather.

Total steps: 3

Start point: Combe Wood lay-by, grid ref: ST161016

1. Go through the gate into the site and head up the main ride.
2. Turn right and follow the waymarked route around the wood. The good thing about this walk is that it's almost impossible to get lost. All you need to do is keep the edge of the wood to your right.
3. If you take any of the paths that go off to the left you'll simply cut a portion of the circle. Continue walking, keeping the wood on your right until you return to the main gate onto the main road.

End point: Combe Wood lay-by, grid ref: ST161016
