The Souter saunter

On this two mile walking trail, you'll discover much more than a lighthouse standing alone on the coast. Follow coastal footpaths to discover a lost village, a nature reserve on the site of a former colliery, interesting rock formations and a beautiful bay.

Maintained paths, fairly flat, no steep inclines.

Total steps: 9

Start point: Foghorn Field, grid ref: NZ407641

- Start your journey from the Foghorn House. Make your way through the gate and continue to the coastal footpath.
- 2. Turn left and follow the coastal path along to the fence.
- 3. Follow the fence line until you reach the public footpath.
- 4. Turn left again and follow the public footpath past the lighthouse and through to the entrance to the car park about 550yd (500m).
- 5. Turn right this time follow the road down to the car park. It's signposted Whitburn Coastal Park so it's difficult to get lost.
- 6. Take the path around the Nature Reserve and stop off at the viewing screens for a spot of bird watching.
- 7. Pick up the coastal path again at the bird hide, take a left and start to make your way back towards the lighthouse.
- 8. Continue along the coastal path.
- 9. Continue along the coastal path to the fence line and take a left back towards the Foghorn House.

End point: Foghorn Field, grid ref: NZ407641
