


NOTTINGHAMSHIRE & LINCOLNSHIRE

Gunby ice house pond walk

Terrain

Grass field and coarse stone path.

Total steps: 7

Start point: Gunby Hall and Gardens

- 1. Enter the gardens through the ornamental gates at the front of the house. Go left past the house and follow the garden path towards the church.
- 2. Leave the gardens and go through the gate on your left before the church.
- 3. Go past the church and bear right following the fenceline of the gardens. From time to time, the field will be home to our tenant farmer's herd of Lincoln Red cattle, in case you have a dog. Look to your left and you will see the remains of the deserted medieval village.
- 4. When you reach the fence which divides the fields, turn left and head towards the clump of trees.
- 5. Go through the gate and you have arrived at the ice house pond.
- 6. Walk around the pond and enter the field through the gate.
- 7. Pass through the wrought iron kissing gate, and return to the gardens following the one way system to the courtyard.

End point: Gunby Hall and Gardens
