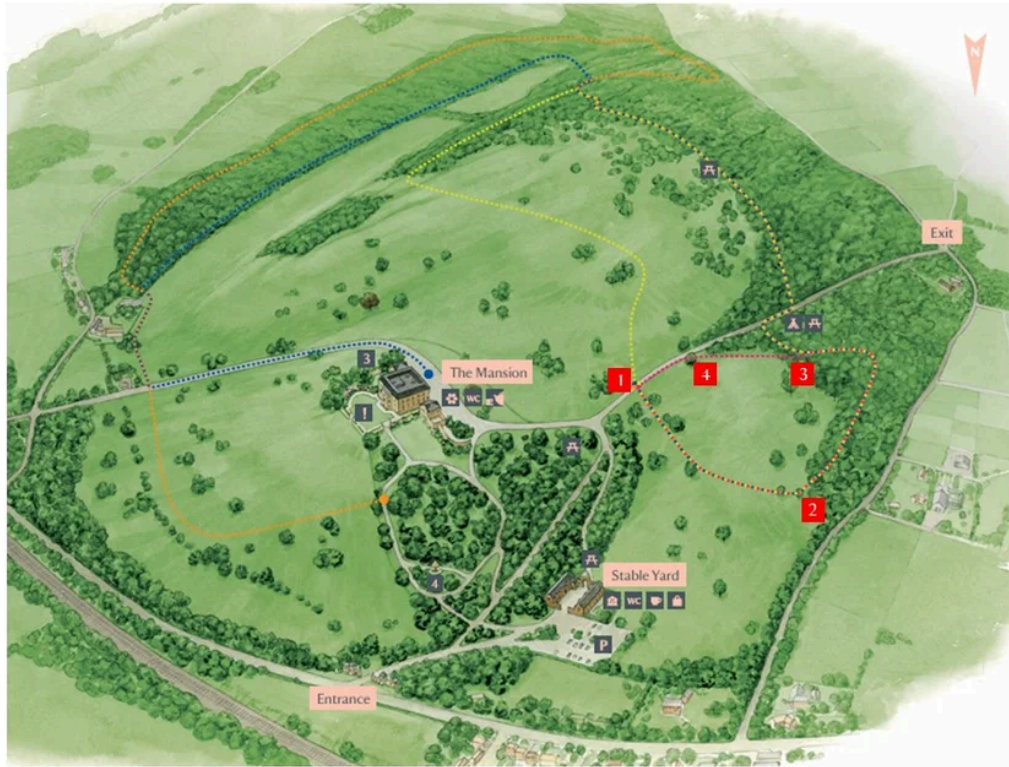

## Pheasant Walk at Basildon Park, Berkshire

Set in 400 acres of parkland, the Pheasant Walk is one of four trails for you to enjoy at Basildon Park which is suitable for families with young children



### **Pheasant park walk** 0.5 miles / 20 mins (red trail)

Over the carriage drive, through the Pheasant park, into the woodland and back to the mansion down the drive. Suitable for pushchairs.

Note that from early Spring to late Autumn, the Pheasant park is home to grazing cattle. Please keep dogs under close control.

### Total stages: 4

Start point: The trail starts a little way up the road near the mansion house.

1. Head through the gate on the right hand side of the road as you walk away from the mansion house. This takes you into the Pheasant park (What3Words gate location [///faces.grazes.fluffed](#))
2. Make your way across the field, crossing the causeway and bearing left towards the gate at the top of the field.
3. Pass through the gate and enter the first part of the woodland and follow the path.
4. When you come to the fork in the path, bear left and skirt the woodland. Exit the field through the gate which takes you back onto the road [no - the path is outside the field, alongside the fence]. Keep following this until you reach the start point. (Alternatively, if you find that path too narrow, continue a little further on the main path and that will take you to the road.

End point: The end location is back on the road in front of the Mansion House where you started from.
