




OXFORDSHIRE, BUCKINGHAMSHIRE & BERKSHIRE

Buscot Purple Woodland Walk

Explore the nearby woodland on this scenic three-mile circular walk, which passes through Coxwell Wood and Oak Wood, and offers open views across the surrounding countryside.

Dog friendly: Dogs welcome under close control, and

Full trail: Miles: 4.5 (km: 7.2)

Access: Challenging

Duration: 1 hour 30 mins

Terrain

Mixture of hard paths, woodland paths and field paths. Route can be muddy after wet weather. There are a couple of moderate slopes, entering and exiting woodlands.

Total steps: 7

Start point: Badbury National Trust Car Park

- 1. Park at the National Trust car park at Badbury Hill.
- Follow the track away from the car park and down through the woods, then enter the open farm land.
- 3. Follow the hedgelines to Brimstone Farm.
- 4. Turn right through the farmyard and continue past Oldfield Farm towards the Buscot Park cricket club.
- 5. Turn right here through a gate along a track.
- Follow the waymarkers carefully as they take you through the woods, then turn to the right through Oak Wood, finally coming back out onto open farm land beneath Coxwell Woods.
- 7. Follow the way markers back up to Badbury Hill.

End point: Badbury National Trust Car Park
