
Nunnington Hall to Bransdale cycle loop trail

Start point: Nunnington Hall, grid ref: SE6703679492

- 1. Turn left out of Nunnington Hall and over the bridge to follow The Ave.
- 2. Turn left at the crossroads and left again at West Ness.
- Turn left and cross the River Wye. 3.
- 4. At the T-junction turn left onto Moor Lane and through Welburn.
- Cross the A170 and turn right and then right again. 5.
- 6. Turn left onto Starfits Lane and left at Fadmoor.
- 7. Continue north and turn left into Bransdale Road through Cockayne.
- 8. Return south down Cowhouse Bank to Helmsley.
- 9. Turn left onto the A170 and right into Acres Lane towards Harome.
- 10. Keep right on Riccal Moor Lane, turning right to return to Nunnington Hall.

End point: Nunnington Hall, grid ref: SE6703679492
