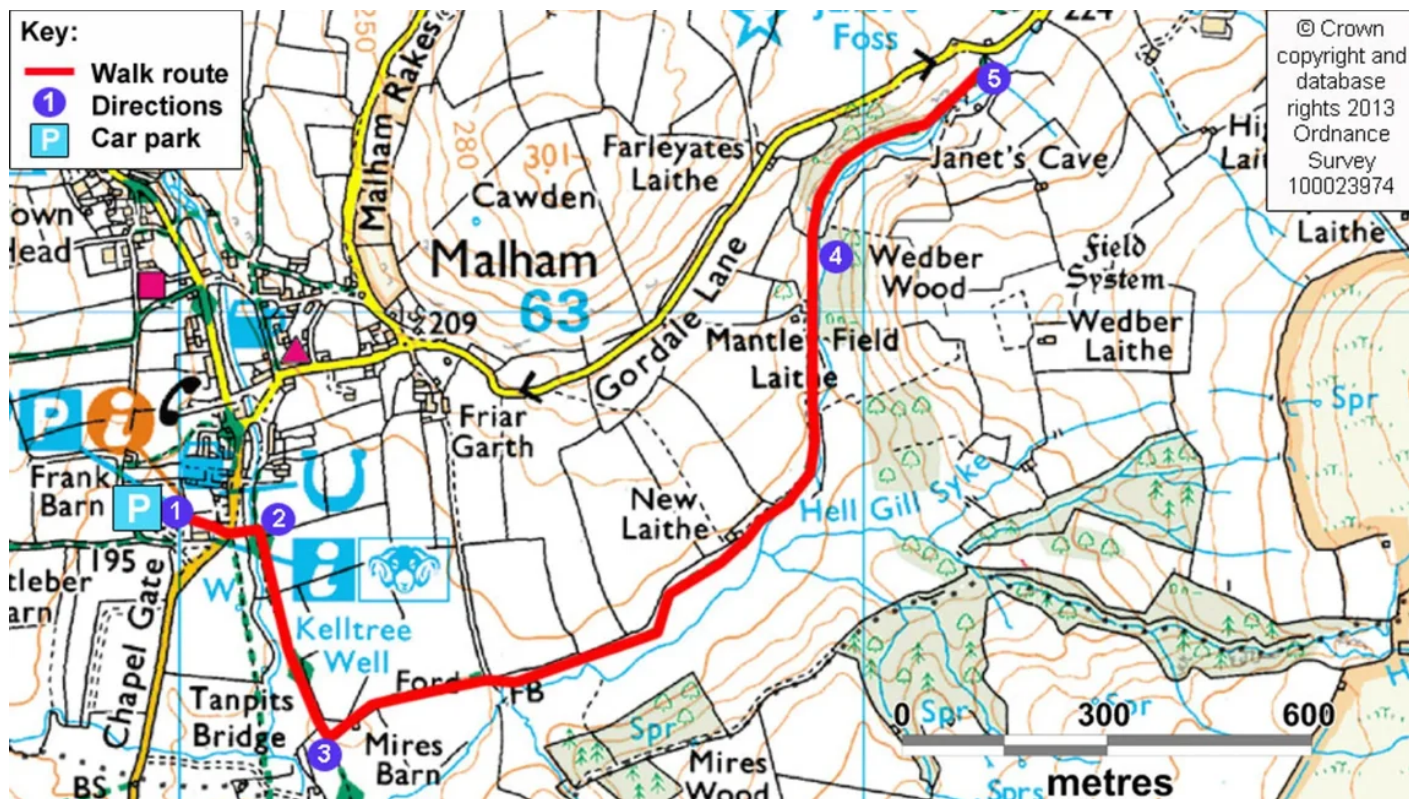

## Malham village to Janet's Foss

This is a popular walk from Malham village to the magical waterfall at Janet's Foss.

### Terrain

Gravel and stone-flagged paths through fields, then uneven rough track through woodland with rocky steps.

### Total steps: 5

Start point: National Park Centre car park, Malham, Skipton, North Yorkshire, BD23 4DA. Grid ref: SD899627

1. From the car park walk into the village, crossing the beck to the right of Malham Smithy.
2. Turn right and follow the beck away from the village, along a gravel pathway.
3. Turn left at the signpost to Janet's Foss and follow this stone-flagged path, with the beck to your right.
4. Go through the gate and into the woodland. At this point the path becomes more rocky and uneven – please watch your step.
5. From the waterfall, return the way you came.
