

## Malham village to Janet's Foss

This is a popular walk from Malham village to the magical waterfall at Janet's Foss.

## Terrain

Gravel and stone-flagged paths through fields, then uneven rough track through woodland with rocky steps.

## Total steps: 5

Start point: National Park Centre car park, Malham, Skipton, North Yorkshire, BD23 4DA. Grid ref: SD899627

- 1. From the car park walk into the village, crossing the beck to the right of Malham Smithy
- 2. Turn right and follow the beck away from the village, along a gravel pathway.
- 3. Turn left at the signpost to Janet's Foss and follow this stone-flagged path, with the beck to your right.
- 4. Go through the gate and into the woodland. At this point the path becomes more rocky and uneven please watch your step.
- 5. From the waterfall, return the way you came.
